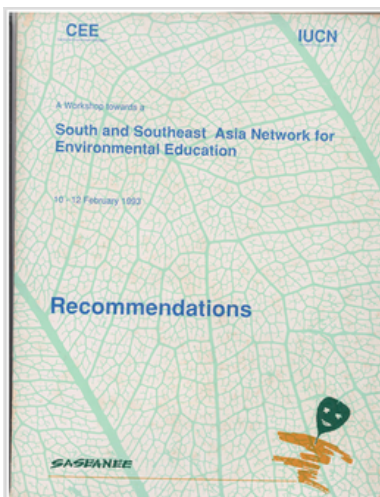

SASEANEE (SOUTH AND SOUTH EAST ASIA NETWORK FOR ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION) CONNECT

SASEANEE Connect aims to build a dynamic global network of organisations committed to enhancing environment literacy and stewardship in South and South East Asia. The interactive digital platform SASEANEE Connect, supported by outreach initiatives would strive to provide invaluable resources, expertise, and strategic insights for diverse audience including youth, educators, local communities, government bodies, and partner organizations promoting green education, capacity building and sustainable living.



In 1993, Centre for Environment Education (CEE) in partnership with IUCN CEC launched SASEANEE, a workshop to bring organizations and people together to share resources, and experiences for Environment education in countries across the region. The workshop brought together 200 delegates from 16 countries who synergized and worked together to provide recommendations across 21 aspects of environmental education. This network further conducted several residential training, newsletters, courses, and multilateral collaborations within countries until 2005. Later this initiative was relaunched as SASEANEE Connect in September 2023.

CELEBRATING WORLD METEOROLOGICAL DAY WITH SOUTH ASIAN METEOROLOGICAL ASSOCIATION (SAMA)

The World Meteorological Day 2024 was jointly celebrated by SAMA, CEE and SASEANEE on 23rd March 2024 online. The theme of the WMO day 2024 was "At the Front Line of Climate Action".

Prof. Coleen Vogel a renowned expert in the field of Climatology (Distinguished Professor, University of the Witwatersrand, Johannesburg, and Member of Scientific Steering Committee of the World Weather Research Program (WWRP) of WMO) delivered the keynote address during the program. Members from the team of SAMA, CEE and SASEANEE presented and discussed their environmental education initiatives in the region. Many people from this region joined the session.

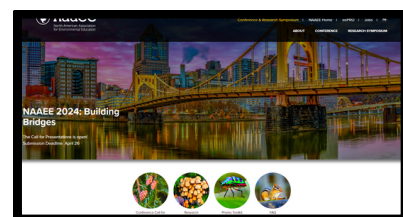
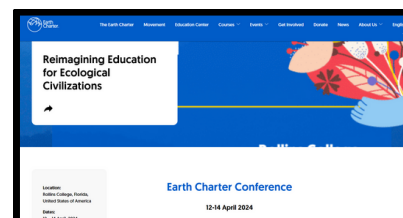
CEE and WWF India have been implementing the UNEP's Tide Turners Plastic Challenge (TTPC) in India since 2019. Since 2018, UNEP has implemented the global challenge in over 30 countries. The challenge focuses attention on awareness and action to find alternatives to single-use plastics and reduce their use in daily life. Youth between the ages of 11 and 35 are involved in the challenge. In India, the challenge has reached out to over 7,00,000 youth.

The initiative is now being extended to Bangladesh and Sri Lanka in joint collaborations with SASEANEE and CEE. The orientation meeting was held online with organisers from Bangladesh and Sri Lanka to outlay the TTPC plan for the International Workshop to be held in 1st and 2nd May 2024 in Ahmedabad, Gujarat.
