SASEANEE at the International Conference on Educating for Sustainability Action

SASEANEE, Centre for Environment Education (CEE) invited researchers, educators, and academics to submit their research papers on the theme "Greening Education: Addressing Triple Planetary Crisis". Selected participants were invited to present their papers at a dedicated paper presentation session in the International Conference on "Education for Sustainability Action" held from January 9-11, 2025, at CEE Ahmedabad. .

Additionally, a session on Green Curriculum was held with speakers from India, Bangladesh, Malaysia and Indonesia focusing on regional insights and strategies for integrating sustainability into education systems .

The conference also served as a valuable networking opportunity for SASEANEE, fostering collaboration, knowledge exchange, and increasing its membership drive.

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PAPER PRESENTATION SESSION

The SASEANEE team organized a Paper Presentation Session on 9th January 2025 during the International Conference on “Educating for Sustainability Action” at the Centre for Environment Education, Ahmedabad.

An Abstract review committee was setup to review the abstracts of papers received across different subthemes addressing the role of “Education in Triple Planetary Crises of climate change, biodiversity loss, and pollution”.

This session featured impactful research contributions from selected presenters addressing critical themes such as sustainability education, climate action, and the role of indigenous knowledge.

Dr. Janki Shah, Programme Director for Sustainable Lifestyles and Traditions at CEE, and Ms. Madhavi Joshi, Director CEE academy and Senior Programme Director, SASEANEE, served as expert panelists. They shared feedback and closing remarks

GREEN CURRICULUM SESSION

The Green Curriculum session hosted by SASEANEE on 10th January 2025 at the ESA Conference 2025 brought together experts to discuss sustainability education across India and South & Southeast Asia, highlighting key insights and initiatives.

Dr. Ram Boojh, Advisor, Mobius Foundation, chaired and moderated the session, highlighting SASEANEE network’s role and the Green Curriculum approach by focusing on interdisciplinary strategies

Ms. Madhavi Joshi emphasized the network’s role in advancing sustainability education across South and Southeast Asia and Ms. Susmita Chanda, Project Coordinator, SASEANEE, gave an overview on the role of the SASEANEE website as a platform with curated resources for EE practitioners, researchers and youth in the region.

Speakers from Indonesia, Malaysia, and Bangladesh shared insights on the green curriculum in their countries, highlighting the need for sustainability in education. Key Recommendations:

- Researching ESD and CCE to address regional climate challenges.
- Need for a holistic approach like the Green School Quality Standards developed by UNESCO.
- Revising curricula for interdisciplinary and climate-focused learning.
- Promoting a whole-school approach to integrate sustainability across education systems.
- Need of more research in South Asia on EE/ESD.
