SASEANEE SESSION AT ICSE

Building Green Skills: Educational Challenges and Opportunities for the Global South

SASEANEE participated at the 7th ICSE organised by Mobius Foundation and hosted a session, titled "Building Green Skills: Educational Challenges and Opportunities for the Global South," on 17 September 2025 (5:30 PM IST). Drawing on regional perspectives, the session explored strategies for integrating ESD competencies into curricula and expanding pathways for youth and communities to participate in equitable and resilient green communities.

The session was moderated by Ms Madhavi Joshi, Sr Programme Director at CEE. Panellists from South Asia and Africa shared diverse perspectives on policy frameworks, higher education, skill-building pathways, and community-driven approaches.

This plenary explored how the Global South can advance sustainability transitions through education and green skills.





















SASEANEE UPDATES



Speaker Highlights

Mr. Kartikeya Sarabhai, Founder Director, CEE (Chair) – Emphasized flexibility and modular training for a rapidly evolving green economy; urged South–South collaboration for effective solutions.

Ms. Presha Ramasarup, EEASA, South Africa – Highlighted need for labour market data to create green job pathways for youth; promoted systemic, community-based skill development.

Dr. Subarna Sivapalan, Associate Dean, University of Nottingham Malaysia – Shared Malaysia's integration of sustainability into higher education; stressed embedding green competencies across disciplines.

Ms. Sharizad Dahlan, Director, ISTIC-UNESCO, Malaysia – Presented the Greening Education for Southeast Asia initiative; focused on transferable competencies, teacher training, and regional cooperation.

Mr. Arpit Sharma, CEO, Skill Council for Green Jobs, India – Showcased successful green skilling models, including solar PV and sanitation worker training; highlighted India's leadership in South–South cooperation.

Dr. Suresh Gautam, HOD, Dept. of Development Education, Kathmandu University – Advocated pedagogy rooted in indigenous knowledge; shared Nepal's local governance collaborations for context-specific green education.

The 7th edition of the International Conference on Sustainability Education (ICSE 2025), hosted by Mobius Foundation at the India Habitat Centre, New Delhi, took place on 17–18 September 2025. Centred on the theme "Sustainability Education for Green Jobs," the conference brought together educators, youth leaders, practitioners, and policymakers from across the globe.

Across two days, sessions explored nature-based solutions, just transitions, and advancing climate literacy as pathways to a sustainable future. Highlights included keynote addresses by leading experts, dynamic youth-led panels, and interactive workshops that emphasized the urgent need to integrate sustainability into education systems. The event created a vibrant platform for collaboration, knowledge exchange, and collective action to equip learners with skills for the green economy.




