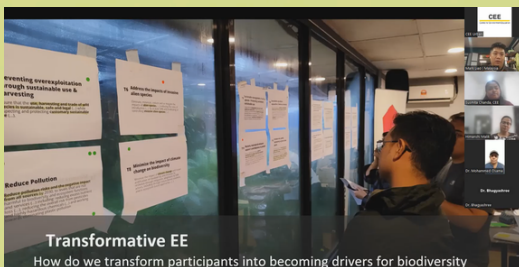

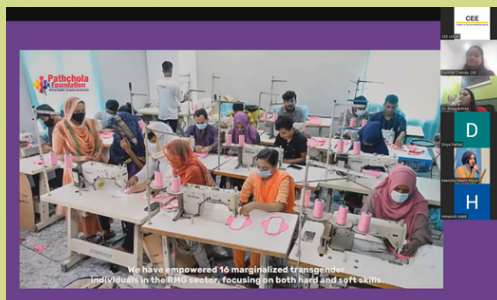


Speakers Highlights

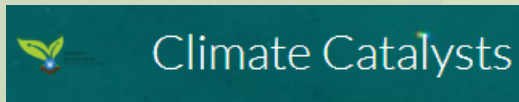

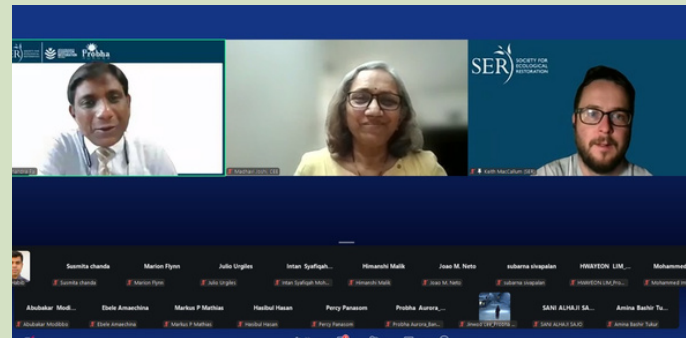


Partner Highlights

Regional Key Takeaways

The SASEANEE team attended the 25th **World Sustainable Development Summit (WSDS)** by TERI on 25–27 February 2026 in New Delhi. Some of the regional highlights and discussions were:

During the panel for Towards a Himalayan Coalition for Sustainable Development, Dr Pema Gyamtsho (ICIMOD) emphasised that "climate knows no borders," urging Himalayan countries to share data for flood and disaster management despite geopolitical tensions.

During the panel on 'Multilateralism as a Force for Hope and Impact' at WSDS, Mr Madhav Prasad Chaulagain from Nepal introduced "Him-CONNECT," a platform connecting Himalayan researchers with startups. He mentioned a project that turns pine needle waste into bio-energy, helping to prevent forest fires and create local jobs.

Mr Indra Mani Pandey (BIMSTEC) at the panel discussion in the Multilateralism series called for a regional agreement among **Bay of Bengal nations** to address climate-induced migration as a humanitarian and security issue.

In the Multilateralism panel, Mr Mattias Frumerie (Sweden) proposed a satellite-based monitoring system to form a "**Global Carbon Police**," aiming to eliminate greenwashing and ensure carbon credits reflect actual emission reductions.

Mr Ovais Sarmad also stressed that "global trust" relies on data; without a common standard for carbon accounting, international cooperation on trade and finance will falter.

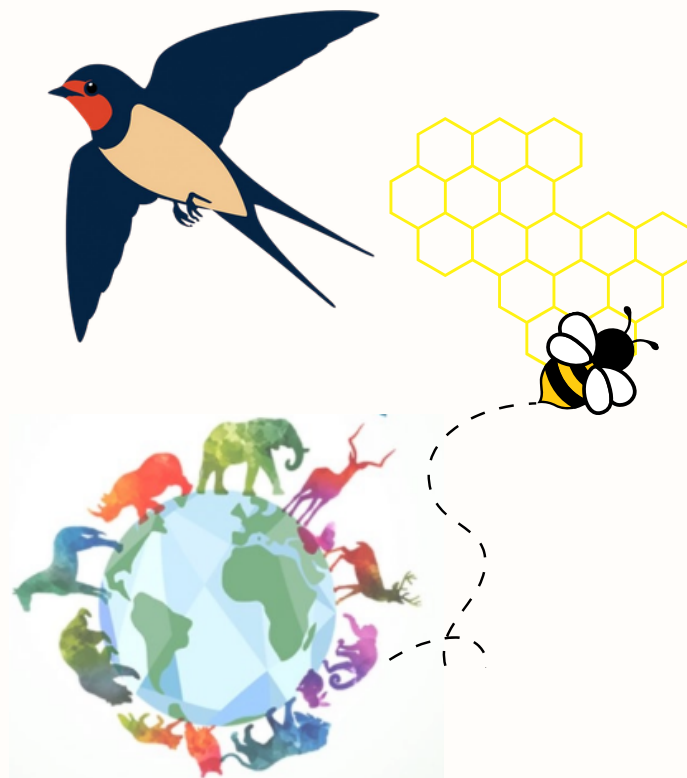
Dr Sujata Gupta, Asian Development Bank, during the Climate Finance Imperative panel, talked about the Special Grant Wind, where allocation of \$440 million (2025-2028) for coastal resilience, water scarcity, and early warning systems in specific countries is given.
